

Terms of Reference

CACLP Best Trainee Presentation Award

Purpose

This award is presented annually to a trainee (medical student, resident or fellow) who has given the best oral or poster presentation at the Annual Meeting.

Award Criteria

All trainee presentations are automatically considered for the award at each Annual Meeting.

Eligibility

To be considered for this award, trainees must be currently enrolled as a medical student, resident or fellow in any professional discipline and be the first author or in the case of an oral presentation, must also be the presenting author of a presentation included in the current year's program during the CACLP Annual Meeting.

Review and Adjudication

Adjudication will be completed by a subset of CACLP members selected annually by the Board of Directors. The recipient will be chosen by consensus from among the trainee presentations, and the adjudicators will notify the Board of Directors of its decision. Adjudication shall take place in camera, and the selection committee has the option to not confer the award in any given year.

Recognition

The recipient will receive \$300 and a certificate in recognition of the accomplishment. CACLP will maintain an official record of recipients online and at its office.
